UPDATES:

- Residents within the Site can expect to see DEP's contractor sampling the monitoring wells the week of December 2nd.
- DEP will begin installing filtration systems over the next several weeks. Homeowners with wells testing above 70 ppt of PFOS/PFOA, and have given permission to DEP for the installation, will be contacted directly by DEP to schedule an appointment for the installation.
- It is not too late for homeowners, with combined PFAS concentrations above 70 ppt that have not already done so, to indicate their willingness to allow DEP to install a filtration system.
 Please indicate your interest by responding to this e-mail or contacting me directly. Please note, we will need a signed Consent for Access and Right of Entry form so that the work can be performed.
- DEP will be transitioning between contractors during the month of December. Tetra Tech, Inc. will be taking over current Site activities from EnviroTrac throughout December, including residential well sampling.
