Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of April 17, 2020, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

Since the last community update sent on April 3, 2020:

- In order to prevent the further spread of Covid-19, DEP offices remain closed until at least April 30, 2020. Staff continue to work remotely, conducting inspections as needed to protect the health and safety of the residents of the Commonwealth, reviewing reports, and otherwise carrying out the mission and work of the Department.
- On April 10 2020, RE Pierson requested additional time to remove equipment from the site. DEP granted an extension until May 4, 2020. The request and approval letter have been posted to the webpage.
- On April 17, 2020, DEP responded to Hanson's request for an extension to respond to comments on the Qualitative Geologic Survey Report (QGSR). Certain provisions of the response have been extended until May 31, while others have been extended to June 30. DEP is also requiring Hanson submit two additional plans by May 31: a revegetation plan and a draft asbestos monitoring plan. The full response is attached and available for review on the webpage.
