Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of September 21, 2020, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

Since the last community update sent on August 17, 2020:

- [DEP offices](#) remain closed to prevent the further spread of COVID-19. Staff continue to work remotely, conducting inspections as needed to protect the health and safety of the residents of the Commonwealth, reviewing reports, and otherwise carrying out the mission and work of the Department.
- Hanson will be on site Tuesday, September 22, to collect a soil sample in anticipation of re-vegetating areas of the property. DEP staff will be on site during this collection to oversee the activity
- Hanson will also periodically be on site to perform water monitoring as required in their surface mining permit, as well as to conduct site security measures.
- PPL (the utility company) is also expected to be on site this week to remove a transformer from the property. DEP will be on site during this activity to ensure all safety measures are adhered to.
- DEP continues to review and post all correspondence and supplemental submissions received.
