RESOLUTION NO. 2011-10

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING AN EMERGENCY IN EAST ROCKHILL TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
LEADING UP TO, DURING AND FOLLOWING HURRICANE IRENE AND TROPICAL STORM LEE

WHEREAS, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Tom Corbett issued a Proclamation of Emergency declaring the existence of a disaster emergency on the 26th day of August, 2011 "urging the governing bodies and executive officers of all political subdivision that may be affected by this emergency to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies as legally authorized under this proclamation, namely, by the employment of temporary workers; by the rental of equipment; and by entering into such contracts and agreements as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted"; and

WHEREAS, East Rockhill Township sustained extensive damage from Hurricane Irene and the subsequent Tropical Storm Lee in the form of downed trees and repeated flooding of public streets and lands:


WHEREAS, it was and continues to be necessary to purchase emergency supplies and contract for emergency services: therefore


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of East Rockhill Township on this 13th day of September that East Rockhill Township has declared the existence of a disaster emergency; and


