Storm Event in the form of downed trees , snow & ice removal and wide spread power outages:


WHEREAS, it was and continues to be necessary to purchase emergency supplies and contract for

8th day of November that East Rockhill Township has declared the existence of a disaster emergency; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Township Board of Supervisors, Township Manager and Director of




