LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the East Rockhill Township Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on June 21, 2011, at 7:00 p.m., at the East Rockhill Township municipal building, 1622 Ridge Road Perkasio, PA 18944 to consider the adoption of an ordinance that will amend Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 201(1) of the Code of Ordinances of East Rockhill Township. The proposed Ordinance establishes a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Hill Road from its intersection with Three Mile Run Road to its intersection with Rockhill Road, and provides for penalties for violations. The Board of Supervisors may adopt this ordinance at the aforementioned meeting.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF EAST ROCKHILL TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, AMENDING SECTION 15-201(1) OF THE EAST ROCKHILL TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES AND ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON HILL ROAD FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THREE MILE RUN ROAD TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH ROCKHILL ROAD.

Preamble

The East Rockhill Township Board of Supervisors, upon the recommendation of the Township Engineer and the Township Roadmaster, and pursuant to the appropriate engineering and traffic studies where necessary, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, Act No. 81, as amended.

ARTICLE II.

Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 201(1), Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets, of the East Rockhill Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by the addition of the following maximum speed limit:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Hill Road	Three Mile Run Road and Rockhill Road	25 mph

ARTICLE III.

The proper authorities of the Township are directed to erect official signs establishing the speed on Hill Road at twenty-five (25) miles per hour, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the Vehicle Code and this Ordinance.

ARTICLE IV.

Repealer. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, and amendments thereof are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

ARTICLE V.

Severability. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

ARTICLE VI.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.
