

**Minutes of the meeting of the
East Rockhill Township Board of Supervisors
September 17, 2002
7:00 p.m.**

Minutes

In attendance were Chairman David R. Nyman, Vice Chairman John R. Cressman and member Gary W. Volovnik, Also present were, Road Superintendent Steven D. Funk, Township Solicitor Jeff Trauger, Township Engineer C. Robert Wynn and John V. Cornell Township Manager as well as members of the Press and public.

Mr. Nyman opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Public Comment: Mr. Nyman opened the meeting to Public Comment. Mr. Tom Brady from the Gardenview at Country Hunt subdivision shared continuing concerns regarding drainage of the detention basin, presence of mosquito larva and potential presence of West Nile Virus, and speeding within the development. Mr. Wynn responded to the various issues. Being no additional comments from the public the meeting resumed.

Item #1. Approval of minutes: By way of motion by Mr. Cressman, vote all in favor the minutes of August 20, 2002 were accepted as presented.

Item #2. Manager's Report: Mr. Cornell noted within the packets there were documents related to his report. Mr. Cornell then presented resolution 2002-08 amending the fee schedule to include a \$5.00 tax bill duplication fee, as requested by the tax collector. Following an explanation and discussion by way of motion vote all in favor the resolution was approved and signed by the Board. Next Mr. Cornell, presented a letter addressed to Perkasio Borough Council, from the Board of Supervisors thanking the council for extending the assistance of the electric department for the renovation on the Pennridge Regional Police new headquarters in West Rockhill Township. Following a reading of the letter, the Board signed the correspondence. Next, Mr. Cornell recommended the Board and Public peruse the updated web site and also announced the planned Bucks County Community College Dollars for Scholars run scheduled for September 28, 2002. The Manager's report was then accepted as presented.

Item #3. Planning Commission Report: Because the Commission had not met in August no report was presented.

Item #4. PWTA Report: Mr. Cressman presented the report by way of review of the July, 2002 PWTA minutes, The PWTA report was then accepted as presented.

Item #5. Engineers' Report: Mr. Wynn first presented a grant of extension for the Mager land development plan until October 31, 2002. Next Mr. Wynn reported the Deibler sewer line extension was complete and recommended final payment. Lastly, the

escrow releases as noted in the C. Robert Wynn Escrow Release Summary dated August 15, 2002, by way of motion, vote all in favor were approved as presented. The Engineer's report was then accepted as presented.

Item #6. Solicitors' Report: Mrs. Eberle presented the Beres Land Development agreements for signature. By way of motion, vote all in favor the Solicitor's Report was then accepted as presented.

Item #7. Emergency Services Report: Mr. Nyman noted the respective fire company reports present in the packet. The report was then accepted as presented.

Public Comment: Mr. Nyman opened the meeting to public comment. Mr. Fleck from West Rock Road shared concerns over the pending Texas Eastern pipeline construction, hours of operation, and blasting. Following discussion, Mrs. Mary Eberle advised that issues related to pipeline easement disputes were civil matters between the property owner and the company. Being no additional comment, the regular meeting resumed.

Item #8. Payment of Bills: By way of motion by, the bill's list for August was approved as presented within the packet.

Item #9. Adjournment: Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at the bills were signed and the evening concluded.
