

Minutes of the East Rockhill Township Board of Supervisors
Re-organization meeting
Monday January 5, 2004
6:30 p.m.
Minutes

In attendance were Board of Supervisors John R. Cressman, David R. Nyman and Gary W. Volovnik. Also present, Road Superintendent Steven D. Funk, and John V. Cornell Township Manager as well as members of the Press and public.

Mr. Nyman opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Mr. Nyman then turned the meeting over to Mr. Cornell for the purpose of electing a Chairman for year 2004. Mr. Cornell opened the floor to nominations. Mr. Nyman nominated Mr. Cressman, Mr. Volovnik seconded the nomination. Mr Cressman accepted the nomination. Being no additional nominations, Mr. Cornell called for a vote. The vote was all in favor. At this time, Mr. Cornell turned the meeting over to Mr. Cressman. Mr. Cressman, opened the floor to nominations for Vice-chairman. Mr. Nyman nominated Mr. Volovnik, Mr. Volovnik accepted the nomination, being no further nominations Mr. Cressman called for a vote. Vote all in favor Mr. Volovnik was elected vice-chairman.

Item #1. Resolution 2004-01 Reorganization

Mr. Cressman, read each article of resolution 2004-01 aloud. Following the reading, motion was made, seconded and the provision approved. Following the approval of each article as presented with the exception Article I was amended to include Mr. Cressman as a standing representative to the Pennridge Regional Police. Mr Volovnik reminded the Board it was West Rockhill Township's turn to chair the Commission, therefore East Rockhill Township needed two representatives. The resolution was then approved and signed.
