

**MINUTES OF
THE WORK SESSION OF
THE EAST ROCKHILL TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
March 9, 2004**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mr. Cressman , Mr. Volovnik and Mr. Nyman as well as John Rice, Steven Funk, Steven Baluh and John Cornell and members of the Public.

Public Comment: Mr. Cressman opened the meeting to public comment. Being no public comment the meeting resumed.

Approval of Minutes: At this time, by way of motion vote all in favor the January 5, 2004 reorganization and February 10, 2004 minutes were approved as presented.

Item #1. Manager's Report: Mr. Cornell, introduced representatives from the Pennridge Yellow Jackets Soccer Association. Discussion took place regarding fields and field use. It was agreed the organization would internally explore development of the potential locations and coordination with the Deep Run organization. Next, representatives from Ben-Jee Kennel were present to discuss a future indoor dog training facility. Following discussion it was agreed they would explore the High-line facility and treatment site. Next, Mr. Cornell along with Mr. Funk reported on the status of the golf course staff meetings. Next following discussion the agreed the township was not in a position reimburse the Greenjackets football for the sewer line installation. Mr. Cornell was directed to convey the township had paid for the well installation and had waived the connection cost as well as the quarterly sewer charges. Lastly the Board directed Mr. Rice to advertise the posting of White Road "No Trucks" due the road conditions and to reduce the speed limit on Schwenkmill Road. A suggestion was also made to explore abandonment of the White road. It was agreed to informally further investigate the concept. The Manager's report was then accepted as presented.

Item #2. PWTA Report: Mr. Cressman reported on the last meeting held at PWTA including, plant completion, and the sale of EDU's to Hilltown Water & Sewer Authority. The PWTA report was then accepted as presented

Item #3. Engineer's Report: Mr. Steve Baluh presented the Three Mile Run Road improvement and storm-water control plan. The Engineer's report was then accepted.

Item #4. Solicitor Report: Mr. Rice discussed his memorandum regarding the Richland Township Comprehensive plan changes. He also requested an executive session to discuss litigation. The Solicitor's report was then accepted.

Item #5. PACC: Mr. Cressman reported on the last PACC meeting and Mr. Nyman reported on a meeting held regarding municipal assistance in financing the Pennridge Senior Center.

Item #6. Other Business: Mr. Nyman requested the staff investigate the status of the EPA water study and Mr. Cressman shared comments regarding the Mood's Covered Bridge repairs.

Public Comment: Mr. Cressman opened the meeting for public comment, being none the meeting was adjourned.

Item #7. Adjournment: the meeting adjourned into executive session, following the session the evening concluded, no formal action was taken.
