

**MINUTES OF  
THE  
THE EAST ROCKHILL TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
April 11, 2006**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were, Chairman Mr. Gary W. Volovnik, Vice Chairman Mr. David R. Nyman and member Mr. John R. Cressman. Also present were Solicitor John Rice, Engineer C. Robert Wynn, Director of Public Works Steven Funk, and Township Manager John V. Cornell and members of the Press and Public.

Item #1. Approval of Minutes: At this time, by way of motion, vote all in favor the minutes of March 14, 2006 were approved as presented.

Public Comment: Mr. Volovnik opened the meeting to public comment. Being no public comment the meeting resumed.

Item #2. Manager's Report: Mr. Cornell first presented resolution 2006-07 authorizing signatures and approval of the DCNR Natural Areas grant application related to the Tohickon Campground. By way of motion vote all in favor the resolution was approved. Next the Board reviewed a series of sign designs for entry locations. It was agreed to request a cost for the preferred sign based on 15 intended signs. Next Mr. Cornell provided an update on the recycling report generated by FX Brown. Next following discussion the solicitor's office was directed to move forward with re-bidding the Cedarbrook Crossing trash district. Lastly the Board discussed the petroleum product bid results as bid by the Bucks County Consortium, it was agreed the actual bid would awarded at the regular meeting. The Manager's report was then accepted as presented.

Item #3. PWTA Report: Mr. Cressman commented on the last meeting. It was reported the EDU policy had been tabled. The PWTA report was then accepted as presented.

Item #4. Solicitor's Report: Mr. Rice noted he had two real estate items to discuss in executive session. The solicitors report was then accepted as presented.

Item #5. Engineer's Report: Mr. Wynn discussed the status of the Cinnabar Farms subdivision and following discussion it was agreed to contact the property owners along Branch Road related to the recently bid sewer line extension. The engineer's report was then accepted as presented.

Other Business: Mr. Nyman reported on discussions with the Perkasio Ambulance Corp and their operations. Mr. Funk then reported of the reed bed placement for the treatment plant and noted the work would be preformed in-house for about \$12,000.00 He was authorized to proceed.

Public Comment: Mr. Volovnik then opened the meeting for public comment, Being no public comment the meeting was adjourned into executive session for a real estate matter at 8:10 pm.

Item #9. Adjournment: Following the executive session and adjournment the bills were signed and the evening concluded with no other formal action.
