**A RESOLUTION DECLARING EAST ROCKHILL TOWNSHIP'S
SUPPORT FOR ITS ELECTED TAX COLLECTOR IN THE
APPEAL BY THE PENNRIDGE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO
UNFAIRLY REDUCE THEIR COMPENSATION**

WHEREAS, East Rockhill Township's Tax Collector was appropriately elected by the Township's electorate; and

WHEREAS, the Pennridge School District did attempt to arbitrarily and capriciously set their rate of compensation unreasonably low; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector sought relief from the Bucks County Court of Common Pleas; and

WHEREAS, the Bucks County Court of Common Pleas did determine the rate of compensation to be unreasonably low and should be established at a reasonable market rate; and


WHEREAS, the Pennridge School District has decided to appeal the ruling of the Bucks County Court of Common Pleas; and


