Pursuant to Section 702 of the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors hereby establishes the Bond for the Treasurer and Bookkeeper in the amount of \$250,000.00.

**ARTICLE XI.**

**EMPLOYEE WAGES AND BENEFITS:**

All regular full-time employees shall receive wage increases and adjustments as approved by the 2012 budget adoption. Employee benefits as outlined in the October 2009 employee

handbook adopted by Resolution Number 2009-24. Be it resolved that all full-time participating non-uniformed employees shall contribute 5% to the township pension plan held by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System for the year 2012.






