The East Rockhill Township Park and Recreation Board met on November 14, 2017 at 7:00 pm at the East Rockhill Township Municipal Building, 1622 N. Ridge Road, Perkasio, PA 18944. The following members were present:

Meeting notes dated May 23, 2017 were reviewed and accepted.

New Business:

New Meeting Date: Park and Recreation meeting night has been moved to the 2nd Tuesday on a quarterly basis and has been re-advertised. The 2018 meeting dates will be advertised for February 13, 2018, May 8, 2018, August 14, 2018 and November 13, 2018 on an as-needed basis.

2018 Proposed Budget Park Items: In the 2018 preliminary budget proposed park items are Willard H. Markey Centennial Park driveway fence replacement, golf driving range shed replacement, and planning services for a sketch plan for grant applications showing proposed improvements, active recreation uses, passive recreation uses and natural resources to be protected on Township owned property totaling 133 acres at the Iron Bridge Park location. Daylilies under the Markey Park driveway fence was suggested.

Willard H. Markey Centennial Park Parking: Mrs. Blodgett has been advised of safety concerns at the Willard H. Markey Centennial Park when the Yellowjacket soccer organization and Greenjacket soccer organization hold games at the same time. It was noted the fall season is ending. Mrs. Morano will contact the sport organizations to seek a solution for the spring season. Mrs. Blodgett offered her assistance.

Old Business:

Run the Rocks 5K Event: September 16 Run the Rocks event was cancelled and is anticipated to be rescheduled to spring 2018. The event will be held in East Rockhill Township. Mrs. Blodgett advised she would call Officer DiGiovanni.

Pines of Pennridge Playset: The new playset has been purchased to replace existing playset adjacent to the Pines of Pennridge development and Fifth Street. Installation will be when time allows. A rendering of the playset was provided.

PA Highland Trail Network:
