Approval of Minutes from January 24, 2018 Regular Meeting

On motion by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Keyser, to adopt the meeting minutes from the Pennridge Regional Police Commission's February 28, 2018 Regular Meeting. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Financial Report: Chief Blake

Chief Blake read the financial report dated March 28, 2018. After payment of the monthly bills totaling \$80,038.18 the total operational account balances equal \$158,985.52. The capital reserve account funds total \$264,818.28. Chief Blake mentioned that this bills list includes the purchase of a new police vehicle. Chief Blake commended the Board on being financially sound. He added that this is the second vehicle purchased in his tenure that was not leased, which is a cost savings to the tax payer. Mr. Keyser asked Chief Blake the time frame for the vehicle to be ready for the street. Chief Blake estimated that it would be ready in seven days.

On motion by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Keyser, to approve payment of Bills List dated March 28, 2018 totaling \$80,038.18 and the Financial Report as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Chief's Report: Chief Blake

Chief Blake read the monthly report indicating Department activities for the month of February 2018. The report is on file. **On motion** by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Keyser, to approve the Chief's Report as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Solicitors Report: John B. Rice, Esq.

Mr. Rice announced that the Board had some dates to choose for a meeting in reference to the HVAC litigation. He advised that the letter was in their packet.

On motion by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Keyser, to approve the Solicitor's Report as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.
