

**Pennridge Regional Police Commission

The regular business meeting of the Pennridge Regional Police Commission was held at 7:00pm on July 25, 2018 in the meeting room at the Pennridge Regional Police Headquarters, 200 Ridge Road, Sellersville, PA 18960.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Alternate Chairperson Mr. Miller with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Citizen Comment #1:

There was none.

Announcements:

Mr. Miller advised that there would be an Executive Session after the meeting to discuss personnel issues. He also advised that Mr. Dave Nyman, Supervisor of East Rockhill Township, is sitting as the alternate for Commissioner Gary Volovnik.

Approval of Minutes from April 25, 2018 Regular Meeting

On motion by Mr. Keyser, seconded by Mr. Nyman, to adopt the meeting minutes from the Pennridge Regional Police Commission's June 27, 2018 Regular Meeting. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Financial Report: Chief Blake

Chief Blake read the financial report dated June 27, 2018. After payment of the monthly bills totaling \$66,160.42 the total operational account balances equal \$232,574.37. The capital reserve account funds total \$265,130.76.

On motion by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Keyser, to approve payment of Bills List dated June 27, 2018 totaling \$66,160.42 and the Financial Report as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Chief's Report: Chief Blake

Chief Blake read the monthly report indicating Department activities for the month of June 2018.

On motion by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Keyser, to approve the Chief's Report as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Solicitors Report: John Rice, Esq.

Mr. Rice reported that there would be an Executive Session to discuss litigation matters.

Old Business

Chief Blake advised that Red Cross Blood Drive was a huge success with 21 pints of blood received which means 63 potential lives were saved. Chief Blake gave a thumbs up to the Pennridge Community. Mr. Nyman praised the department for taking the initiative in organizing the event.

Chief Blake then reminded the Board that at last month's meeting the 2019 Pennridge Regional Police Budget Proposal was submitted. He suggested that as they look it over they should begin to discuss it.

New Business

Chief Blake advised of a praise from a citizen to Officer Dean and Officer Lehman for their professional demeanor at a crash scene

Chief Blake advised that the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency Juvenile Court Judges' Commission recently audited the practices of how the department handles juvenile offenders. The department was found to be in compliance.

Citizen Comment #2:

Mr. Chad Davis, 2315 Finland Road Green Lane, PA, spoke about the traffic accidents on Finland Road in West Rockhill Township. Chief Blake advised that he met with Mr. Miller to discuss the issues and that Mr. Miller was going to contact a representative from Pa Dot and Representative Staats and request that more signage be put in place. Mr. Nyman suggested to Mr. Davis that he also contact Mr. Staats and Pa Dot.

Adjournment

On motion by Mr. Keyser, seconded by Mr. Miller, to adjourn the meeting. With no additional discussion, the meeting was adjourned at 7:18 pm.
