DEP Information Meeting March 5, 2021

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) held an information meeting to update local elected and appointed officials to provide the status of the Rock Hill Quarry located on North Rockhill Road since the last meeting which convened February 5, 2021.

The Rock Hill Quarry is still under a DEP cease order.

Hanson Aggregates' response to DEP's November 18, 2020 technical deficiency letter was received on January 15, 2021. The submission is under DEP review and a written response will be issued. The January 15, 2021 submission indicates that Hanson Aggregates intends site activities to be limited to the removal of the minimum 500 tons of aggregate annually from existing stockpiles, collecting monthly NPDES water discharge samples, and routine site inspection and security detail.

DEP is taking East Rockhill Township and Erskine Environmental correspondence into consideration as they draft an additional technical deficiency letter to Hanson Aggregates.
