DEP Information Meeting April 9, 2021

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) held an information meeting to update local elected and appointed officials to provide the status of the Rock Hill Quarry located on North Rockhill Road since the last meeting which convened March 5, 2021.

The Rock Hill Quarry is still under a DEP cease order.

Hanson Aggregates' response to DEP's November 18, 2020 technical deficiency letter was received on January 15, 2021. The submission is under DEP review and a technical review response is anticipated to be finalized by April 13, 2021 requesting additional information with a deadline of July 6, 2021.

The January 15, 2021 submission indicates that Hanson Aggregates intends site activities to be limited to the removal of the minimum 500 tons of aggregate annually from existing stockpiles, collecting monthly NPDES water discharge samples, and routine site inspection and security detail. After additional information has been received as cited in DEP's anticipated April 13 correspondence, DEP intends to render a decision on Hanson Aggregates' submission.

EPA offered to respond if DEP submits a written request for technical assistance but otherwise does not intend to intervene in DEP's review.
