DEP Information Meeting June 4, 2021

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) held an information meeting to update local elected and appointed officials to provide the status of the Rock Hill Quarry located on North Rockhill Road since the last meeting which convened April 9, 2021.

The Rock Hill Quarry is still under a DEP cease order.

Hanson Aggregates' response to DEP's November 18, 2020 technical deficiency letter was received on January 15, 2021. DEP's technical review response dated April 12, 2021 requested additional information and clarification with a deadline of July 6, 2021.

The January 15, 2021 submission indicated that Hanson Aggregates intends site activities to be limited to the removal of the minimum 500 tons of aggregate annually from existing stockpiles, collecting monthly NPDES water discharge samples, and routine site inspection and security detail. However, Hanson Aggregates recently indicated they will be submitting a request in writing for an extension to the deadline in order for them to provide documentation from their consultants and potentially amend the scope of their request regarding future activities on the site. Once received, the correspondence from Hanson Aggregates will be posted to the DEP Rock Hill Quarry webpage.
