Consideration in hiring full time officer: Chief Dickinson requested permission to move forward with the hiring of Michael Klein, to replace the vacancy of Sgt. Maloney.

On motion by Mr. Keyser, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to hire Michael Klein to the probationary position of patrolman effective December 19th 2022, with no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Consideration of extending the current promotional list: Chief Dickinson requested that the Commission extend the eligibility of the promotional list for the position of Sergeant for a year, setting the expiration of the promotion list to occur on the date of the January 2024 Commission meeting.

On motion by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Keyser, to extend the eligibility of the current Sergeant promotional list, with no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Chief Dickinson made an announcement to the Commission that he had received word that the department had been awarded a \$648,408 grant from the PA Commission on Crime and Delinquency. The Chief explained that the funding was obtained to upgrade the current Records Management System and also install stationary License Plate Readers (LPR) at seven intersections located in East and West Rockhill Township.
